THE MOST REVEREND MICHAEL F. BURBIDGE

Bishop of Arlington, Founder's Award Recipient

On June 8, 2006, Pope Benedict XVI appointed Bishop Burbidge the fifth bishop of the Catholic Diocese of Raleigh. On October 4, 2016, he was announced by Pope Francis as the fourth bishop of the Catholic Diocese of Arlington. Bishop Burbidge is a member of several Boards of Trustees, including The Catholic University of America, Mount St. Mary's Seminary, the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception, Catholic International University, and the Commissariat of the Holy Land. Bishop Burbidge has held a number of leadership positions at the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and previously served as Chairman of the USCCB Committee on Clergy, Consecrated Life and Vocations and the Committee for Communications, and currently as Chairman of the Committee on Pro-Life Activities.



MARIA SOPHIA AGUIRRE, PHD

President, Catholic International University

Dr. Maria Sophia Aguirre was appointed president of Catholic Distance University on July 1, 2023. A Professor Emeritus of Economics at The Catholic University of America, she holds a PhD in Economics from the University of Notre Dame and degrees in Finance and Accounting earned in Argentina. She is the founder of the Integral Economic Development theory and methodology. She has researched, published, and lectured in the areas of international finance and exchange rates, as well as on theories of population, human and social capital, and family as they relate to economic development. She is a Fulbright scholar and has represented countries at international organizations, including the Holy See, and served the U.S. President and Secretary of State as an appointee for two presidential terms. Dr. Aguirre is a Fulbright Scholar.
