

## Liberal Arts Adjunct Faculty

Catholic International University occasionally has a need for new adjunct faculty in a variety of disciplines. We offer undergraduate Liberal Arts studies and graduate studies in Liberal Arts Education exclusively online during five eight-week terms each academic year. Qualified individuals in the following areas are encouraged to apply: Art, Architecture, Composition, Computer Science, History, the Liberal Arts Tradition, Mathematics, Music, Philosophy, Physics, Social Sciences, the Visual Arts, or World Languages. Applicants will become part of an adjunct pool and will receive a response and be interviewed only if a suitable need arises. Interested applicants should email a CV and a cover letter. The letter should indicate whether the applicant is interested in teaching courses in English or in Spanish, and should express the applicant's understanding of Ex Corde Ecclesiae in general and how it relates to the applicant's discipline. Applicants can also include transcripts, letters of reference, and writing samples, but these items are not necessary at this stage. Catholic International University seeks applicants who are rooted in the Catholic intellectual tradition, enjoy teaching and research, and seek to support the mission of the university. Ideal candidates will have completed a terminal degree or be in the process of completing a terminal degree: PhD, STL, STD, MFA, DA, DMA, EdD, DSc, or similar degrees.
